Accommodation

Room keys can be collected from Glen Eyre Halls reception desk (open 24 hours). Please consult your Welcome Pack for information and consult Halls staff should you need any assistance during your stay.

Travel

Public Transport

The nearest rail station is Southampton Central, from where a taxi here will cost approximately £8. There is also the Uni-link bus service **U1** (for times go to <http://www.unilinkbus.co.uk/times.shtml>).

By Car

Highfield campus lies to the north of the city and is easily accessible by motorway and by following the main routes into Southampton. The postcode of the venue is **SO17 1BJ**. Residential delegates are entitled to park at Glen Eyre Halls. Regrettably, no parking is available for day delegates and the University car parks are regularly patrolled. Some on-street parking is available in Hawthorn and Chamberlain roads, to the south west of the campus.
